## HOUSE BILL NO. 4918

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code," (MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81g.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 81g. (1) A person who assaults or assaults and batters an 2 individual while the individual is performing the individual's 3 duties as the operator of a bus, street railway vehicle, or train, or because of the individual's status as an employee or contractor 4 of a bus service, street railway service, or railroad, is quilty of 5 6 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 93 days 7 or a fine of not more than \$1,000.00, or both. A violation of this subsection after a prior conviction of this section is a 8 9 misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 180 days

- 1 or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 2 (2) A person who assaults an individual without a weapon and
- 3 inflicts serious or aggravated injury on that individual without
- 4 intending to commit murder or to inflict great bodily harm less
- 5 than murder on an individual while the individual is performing the
- 6 individual's duties as the operator of a bus, street railway
- 7 vehicle, or train, or because of the individual's status as an
- 8 employee or contractor of a bus service, street railway service, or
- 9 railroad, is quilty of a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for
- 10 not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 11 A violation of this subsection after a prior conviction of this
- 12 section is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 2
- 13 years or a fine of not more than \$4,000.00, or both.
- 14 (3) A person who assaults an individual with a gun, revolver,
- 15 pistol, knife, iron bar, club, brass knuckles, or other dangerous
- 16 weapon without intending to commit murder or to inflict great
- 17 bodily harm less than murder while the individual is performing the
- 18 individual's duties as the operator of a bus, street railway
- 19 vehicle, or train, or because of the individual's status as an
- 20 employee or contractor of a bus service, street railway service, or
- 21 railroad, is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not
- 22 more than 4 years or a fine of not more than \$4,000.00, or both. A
- 23 violation of this subsection after a prior conviction of this
- 24 section is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 8
- 25 years or a fine of not more than \$8,000.00, or both.
- 26 (4) This section does not prohibit a person from being charged
- 27 with, convicted of, or punished for any other violation of law
- 28 arising out of the same transaction as the violation of this
- 29 section.



- (5) As used in this section: 1
- (a) "Bus" means that term as defined in section 4b of the 2 Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.4b. 3
- 4 (b) "Railroad" means that term as defined in section 109 of the railroad code of 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.109. 5
- 6 (c) "Street railway service" means 1 or both of the following:
- (i) A street railway as that term is defined in section 109 of 7 the railroad code of 1993, 1993 PA 354, MCL 462.109. 8
- 9 (ii) A street railway system as that term is defined in section 10 507 of the recodified tax increment financing act, 2018 PA 57, MCL 11 125.4507.
- (d) "Street railway vehicle" means a streetcar, trolly, or 12 13 tram that is operated on a rail.
- 14 (e) "Train" means railroad train as that term is defined in section 49 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.49. 15
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
